

Covid-19 Update: October 30, 2020

Dear Faith Family,

As we prepare for another week of gathering together for worship and the study of God's Word, I wanted to make you aware of a few things new for this Sunday. There has been a lot of press about the possibilities of coronavirus spikes, and we are taking that very seriously as more people in our community are dealing with it. But it is such a blessing to be with the people of God, and we encourage you to come and experience that if you can. If you still feel led to stay sheltered-in-place, remember that we love you and are providing the Sunday School lesson online on Facebook at 9:30 am and the worship service on both Facebook and YouTube at 10:30 am.

If you plan on attending in person, here are a few things to be aware of this Sunday:

- **We will be partaking of the Lord's Supper.** It is such a special time for our congregation to remember our Savior's love and grace towards us through His crucifixion, and to celebrate that He has called us to be a part of His Kingdom's work by joining as one with our other members of the Faith Family. In an effort to limit the number of hands that touch the communion trays, our deacons have decided to set the elements on tables spread out in the Worship Center. When it is time for the Lord's Supper, we will direct you towards the tables in a manner that promotes physical distancing to receive your communion elements and return to your seats. We will then partake of them together to demonstrate that there is no spiritual separation in the oneness of the Body of Christ. (If you are still sheltered-in-place, we encourage you to grab some crackers and juice at home and be prepared to celebrate the Lord's Supper together with us).
- **We will be removing the chairs that block every other row.** This is no longer legally required of us, and we want to be able to provide more access to seating. We will still encourage the proper physical distancing, and we request people to mask in and mask out, and mask while conversing closely. We know that masks are inconvenient and we trust the Lord for our health, but we also believe that He desires us to be good neighbors and care for others besides ourselves.
- **For the guys... Men's Breakfast is this Sunday at 7:30 am.** We will be using best practices to safely handle the food and have great fellowship. Be sure to come join us.
